	resources. All services are provided at no cost to students. A vast majority of parents report		
	improvements in their children's grades, behavior, mood, and health since joining the program.		
	College attendance is encouraged through a partnership with CA community colleges, and a		
	scholarship program for its graduates. Other organizations also assist Harmony Project in its		
	mission by donating space and facilities for music instruction and performance. Due to COVID		
	restrictions, Harmony Project's students were instructed via internet during the past fiscal year,		
	but in-person music training and performance has been be re-started in the fiscal year ending in		
	June 2022, with the support of organizations donating rehearsal space to Harmony Project's students once again.
